INSTRUCTIONS

Each year, YADAPP Teams develop a Strategies To Act Now (STAN) Plan addressing high school alcohol and other drug use in their communities. After developing a STAN Plan, Teams are encouraged to share their STAN Plan with community leaders such as school administration and other local leaders to gain their support. Teams should spend the school year implementing the STAN Plan and bringing youth-led alcohol and other drug education and prevention programming to their area. Once the STAN Plan is completed, Teams submit a STAN Plan Final Report to report deliverables from their STAN Plan and to show the effectiveness of YADAPP and high school prevention efforts across Virginia.

STAN Plan Final Reports should be submitted to education@virginiaabc.com and are due by June 1.

THE WHEELER AWARD

Morris and Billie Wheeler were longtime advocates of YADAPP and supported youth substance use prevention efforts for over 30 years. In 1981, the Wheelers daughter, Sandy, was killed by a drunk driver. The Wheelers were a part of the initial group of organizers of YADAPP in 1984 and in 1986 the Wheeler Award was established in their honor.

The Wheeler Award recognizes the successful implementation of youth-led substance abuse prevention STAN Plans by Virginia high schools and community organizations serving high schoolers. All monetary awards are coordinated by Virginia ABC.

The STAN Plan Final Report serves as each Team's application for the Wheeler Award. YADAPP Youth Staff review and score STAN Plan Final Reports to award the Wheeler Award.
