YADAPP Visitor Policy

The safety and security of YADAPP Participants, Adult Sponsors, and Staff is our top priority during the YADAPP kick-off conference. The following information outlines the YADAPP Visitor Policy.

Community Partners

- YADAPP values our partnerships and invites community partners to onsite orientations to learn more about the YADAPP program. Community partners include: foundation members, non-profit executive leadership and administrators. Partners must submit a request form no later than July 1.

Parents and friends of current Teams

- Parents and friends of YADAPP Participants and Adult Sponsors are **not** allowed on conference grounds **at any time** during the conference. This includes the Talent Show, evenings and free time.
- Conference attendees are not allowed to leave campus throughout the duration of the conference.

YADAPP Alumni

- Every five years, YADAPP will host an alumni event inviting all alumni to attend. Information for these events will be promoted through our website and Facebook page.

Additional Information

- Approved onsite visitations are Wednesday from 9:00 am – 12:30 pm. This allows the opportunity for YADAPP staff to show you the morning General Session and some portion of the following Adult Sponsor Track Session and Youth Letter Group Sessions.
- All eligible visitors must submit a request form no later than July 1.
- Prior approval must be obtained before attending conference. YADAPP staff will respond to all forms submitted. Persons who arrive to conference without prior approval will immediately be asked to depart.

YADAPP Visitor Policy

- Visitors should check in at the YADAPP Office upon arrival.
- Visitors should wear visitor credentials at all times while on campus.
- Visitors should follow instructions of all YADAPP Staff while on campus.
- Visitors should be courteous of all YADAPP attendees, staff, and property.
- Visitors should be courteous of all Christopher Newport University staff, students and property.
- Visitors should be respectful of all sessions and activities taking place during their attendance.
- Before departure, visitors should check out at the YADAPP Office.

- YADAPP promotes youth leadership, which should be reflected in casual attire, free from inappropriate or suggestive messages, including but not limited to logos of alcoholic beverages, designs, that encourage the use illegal substances, or encourage other illegal activity.
